



The purpose of the Student Dress Code is to outline



- the student has a particular disability or health condition that requires a departure from the dress code; or
- the student or their parents/carers can demonstrate particular economic hardship that prevents them from complying with the dress code.

When the Principal receives a request for an exemption, she/he

The following items may be worn all year round:

Navy blue jacket with school logo or without; and  
Grade 6 students have the option of wearing a special Year 6 hoodie with the RPS insignia.

Red long and short sleeved with school logo.  
Grade 6 students have the option of wearing a special Year 6 navy polo shirt with the RPS insignia.

Plain navy skorts without decoration or brand name can be worn with navy blue  
tights/stockings/leggings; and  
Plain black or navy bike shorts are permitted to be worn.

Navy blue or white socks; and  
Navy blue tights/stockings.

Appropriate footwear is to be worn. Summer sandals with covered toes, school shoes, pull on  
school boots or runners are permitted (dark colours preferable for all). No thongs

Navy broadbrim without decoration or brand name; and  
Navy bucket hat without decoration or brand name.

Navy beanie without decoration or brand name.
